Attendance Expectations

- All students will be required to be present for all zoom meetings during the entire zoom period.
- If your child will not be able to attend a Zoom class for any reason, **the parent/guardian is required to call the school to inform staff of absence.**
- The administration will be strictly monitoring attendance daily on a period by period basis. Unexcused absences will be addressed in the following manner:
 1. First Absence: Office calls home. Teacher follows up to ensure no missed work.
 2. Second Absence: Office calls home. Teacher follows up to ensure no missed work.
 3. Third Absence: Administration will contact home.
 4. Fourth Absence: Office will send a letter home, explaining the next step is referral to the School Resource Officer. Administration will follow up with a phone call.

5. Fifth Absence: Involvement of School Resource Officer.

Daily Time Commitment

High School Students

- Required to be in their assigned zoom sessions for the duration of the class period.
- A maximum of one half-hour of homework will be given per subject area on a daily basis.
- Late daily work must be turned in to the teacher by the end of the school day on Friday.
- Student work turned in after Friday will not be accepted for credit.
- Previously mentioned deadlines do not apply to long-term or ongoing assignments.

Middle School Students

- Required to be in their assigned zoom sessions for the duration of the class period.
- A maximum of 20 minutes of homework will be given per subject area on a daily basis.
- Late daily work must be turned in to the teacher by the end of the school day on Friday.
- Student work turned in after Friday will not be accepted for credit.
- Long-term or ongoing assignments will be accepted per teacher discretion.

Summative Assessment Make-up Policy for Middle School

- Students who score below expectations on summative assessments will be offered additional instruction and time for learning, along with the opportunity to retake summative assessments that they were not successful on.
- Students, within a reasonable time frame, shall be given the opportunity to retake any assessment that he/she fails.
- Before the retake, each student will be required to receive corrective instruction on the material that he/she was not successful in mastering the first time.
